<sup>6</sup> Humanities courses include Arabic 229 through 241, 243 through 247 and 249 / English courses excluding ENGL 231, 237, 238 and 294, and excluding communication skills courses / History 200 through 279 / Archaeology 201 through 231, 235 and 236 / Philosophy 201, 205, 206, 209, 210, 213 through 219, 221 through 224, 230 through 232, and 249 / CVSP201 through 208, 215, 216, 230, 250, 251 and 295 / Fine Arts and Arts History FAAH 221 through 229C, 235, 238, FAAH/Music 240, 241, 245, 247, 248, 260, 261, FAAH/Theater 265, and 270 / AMST 215, 220, 230, 275, 276, and 299C / and SOAN 215, 217, 225 and 250. Other courses may be considered with prior approval from the academic committee.

<sup>7</sup> The Business-electives must be from the chosen concentration area, otherwise, for generic degree the courses can be from any business elective course.

<sup>8</sup> The Arabic Placement test (APT) is optional. Students who do not sit for the APT will have to register in Arabic 201B or any course 211 or above, excluding ARAB 213,214,215,216,217 and 218. The option of taking the APT will be open to students who think they may be too weak to follow course work higher than the basic language course (Arabic 201A). A student who is exempted from Arabic should substitute this course by any 3-credit non-business elective across AUB.

<sup>9</sup> Any 3-credit elective from the offerings of other AUB faculties (not only FAS), excluding ECON 213, EDUC 219, STAT 201, ENMG 500, and AGSC 212.

<sup>10</sup> **Students who elect CVSP 206 may not enroll in CVSP 203 or CVSP 204 and vice versa.**
